Early Registration Discount: Campers who enroll by March 15, 2010 will be billed at the following 2009 basic Tuition Fees: (Discount applies to basic tuition only. Does not apply to trips, transportation or additional programs.)

Full Season	Full day \$2,235	*Half day \$1,350

*Half day options only available for three and four year old campers

Sibling Discount: If three or more children attend camp from the same family, a 10% discount off the basic tuition will be given for the third child and each additional child. (Trips are not discounted.)

Non-Refundable Deposits: Tuition fees include a non-refundable deposit of \$200/session or trip, per child (\$400/full season), with each registration form. *A \$500 non-refundable deposit is required for Costa Rica Rainforest Trip and the National Parks Trip.

Tuition: The balance will be billed and is due and payable in full by June 1, 2010.

Refund Policy: After a registration has been accepted, no refund of fees will be made for absence, failure to attend during the full term of enrollment, delayed attendance at camp, withdrawal or dismissal. Summer Adventure reserves the right to dismiss a camper whose presence is detrimental to the camp. If a camper withdraws from a session or trip, the non-refundable deposit for that session/trip will not be applied to the remaining balance.
